How much do local truck drivers get paid?

NEWSWATCH: The Department of Labour has announced the new minimum wages for South African wholesale and retail truck drivers.

According to <u>a report on BusinessTech</u>, the monthly revised pay is as follows for the period of 1 February 2018 to 28 February 2019:

Driver type	Area A	Area B
Light (3,500 kg or less)	R3 748.79	R3 250.56
Medium (3,501 kg – 9,000 kg)	R4 487.18	R3 883.52
Heavy (9,000 kg – 16,000 kg)	R4 885.48	R4 644.56
Very Heavy (16,001 kg or over)	R5 368.18	R5 104.09

It is reported that the maximum permissible number of hours per week is 45, which translates to nine hours per day, five days a week.

According to the report, drivers can work overtime (e.g. six-day weeks), depending on the agreement they have with their employer.
