"Producing a giant pumpkin requires talent, hard work and of course a bit of luck," explains Dr Johan van Deventer, GM at Freshmark (Shoprite's fruit and vegetable procurement and distribution arm).

"A planting area of between 40m² and 60m² in full sun is required. Once successfully germinated, the pumpkin plant constantly needs to be protected from overexposure to heat and wind. When watering the plant, it is important to try to keep the leaves dry. Last but certainly not least, guarding a giant pumpkin from porcupines and the like can be quite the challenge. So it's no surprise that some producers have been known to sleep next to their
