

Fight night in Nigeria with Kwesé and Kalakoda Boxing

Kwesé has collaborated with Kalakoda Boxing Promotions to bring the Friday Fight Nights series dubbed, *Chaos*, to Lagos, Nigeria, on October 26, 2018.



The much-anticipated rematch between Chomunorwa ‘Sting’ Gondarenda and Tony ‘Sugar’ Salam for Gondarenda’s WBF Africa Cruiserweight title, dubbed *Chaos in Lagos*, will take place at the Federal Palace Hotel in Victoria Island.

With Kwesé’s multiplatform broadcasting approach, Nigerian sports fans will be spoilt for viewing options.
