

Bust nets R1,9m in fake goods

Fake DVDs, CDs, counterfeit clothing and credit-card-cloning machines have been confiscated by police in major busts in Gauteng where goods valued at R1,9m were seized according to *Business Live*.

The *Business Live* report says that 29 people have been arrested and a total of 23 526 fake DVDs and CDs - with a street value of more than R1,2m - were confiscated along with machinery and cloned credit cards worth over R160 000 during a police operation conducted by the Hawks in Pretoria, Johannesburg, Germiston and Roodepoort.
