This talk will explore elements of design often overlooked in our modern lives, and the sometime devastating impact these have on our

social world and environment. Du Preez will introduce the shift from product-focused design, to that of holistic services and systems, as well as issues surrounding sustainability, accessibility and design for social innovation.

Du Preez has a Masters in Design, a Post Graduate Diploma in Higher Education and Training, has collaborated on two design textbooks and has presented at numerous design and education conferences. Her interest in the user experience and service design fields has resulted in a number of international research projects and she is currently completing her doctorate within this field.
