

## 42nd annual PICA Awards winners announced

Avusa's *Elle South Africa*, Woolworths *Taste* by New Media, *RiskSA* from Cosa Communications, and editors Jackie Burger, Peta Krost-Maunder and Sumien Brink were among the big winners last night, Thursday, 17 November 2011, at the 2011 PICA Awards at Sandton Convention Centre, Johannesburg. The awards, held annually, are open to all <u>Association of Magazine Media</u> (formerly <u>MPASA</u>) member publications and acknowledge standards of excellence in magazine publishing and journalism.
