"We want to deliver papers to their homes," Kalenzi said. He announced the new initiative at the on-going Prosperity Expo at Gikondo.

Rose Kanyange, who works with *The New Times* marketing department, said that the reading culture in Rwanda is still low and this is one of the ways to improve it.
