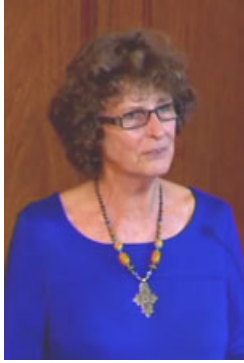


Survé, Dasnois... and 'that' hearing
