

2018 Knysna Motor Show promises 400 classic cars, motorcycles

The 2018 Knysna Motor Show, taking place on 29 April 2018, is aiming to showcase 400 classic cars and motorcycles.

The event's categories will include sports classics, modern classics, veteran and vintage machines built up to 1945, and collectable road and racing motorcycles in both on and off-road guise.



This is an invitation-only event, organised by the Garden Route Motor Club. Part of the event's success can be attributed to the fact that some of the country's finest classic and vintage and veteran machines now reside in lockups and barns located along the Garden Route.

Says Peter Pretorius, chairman of the Garden Route Motor Club: "Last year, shortly after our wonderful show, fires devastated the Garden Route, affecting areas from Knysna, Sedgefield, and surrounding areas even as far as Plettenberg Bay. Some 8,000 people were left homeless, leaving families from formal and informal suburbs seeking urgent relief, supplies and support.
