The Frewin Award category recognises urban daily newspapers with a circulation above 50,000, while the McCall Award category honours urban daily newspapers with a circulation of 50,000 or less. The Joel Mervis category, recognising urban weekly newspapers irrespective of their circulation.

Loxton says the winners epitomise what one expects from them. "Firstly, there is attention to detail in every facet of their work, and secondly, a love of their craft. While they all differ in their "look" they achieve this page after page."

He adds that the competition was very fierce in all three categories and thanked his fellow judges, Logan Naidu, Tebogo Serabatse and Linda Rademan – all recognised experts in their fields, for their valuable contribution.
