Entries are open to print, online, TV and radio reporters/journalists across Southern Africa.

Consideration will be given to journalists who show impact through distribution and engaging audiences using social media channels.

Journalists must show how they have effectively used social media to reach a wider audience on health-related issues; screen shots from the journalist's page must be submitted in PowerPoint presentation form to showcase engagement and reach.

The award will be presented during the awards gala dinner on 17 July 2017 at the annual BHF Southern African Conference to be held at the International Convention Centre, in Cape Town, South Africa. Entries close on Monday 5
